Author Program Book Sale Coloring Program Landscape & Gardening Program Movies





A music mix of mostly old jazz, acoustic guitar and gypsy jazz music played in the background. More music was added for the February session. People colored anything and everything. Some brought their own project and books to color-- pirates and detailed art graphics; and the rest just chose whatever struck their fancy from the art that Tim had printed up. He will be adding more choices to the collection of art to choose from. There is everything from very simple easy-to-color line art to very detailed mandalas, animals, castles, nature scenes, etc. We are also printing up some fold-over coloring stock that can be used as a greeting card with your own colored masterpiece on the front.




#### "Life Without Limits" --- by Nick Vujicic
